REQUEST: Adoption of Ordinance No. 2020-16 adopting The Florida Building Code 7th Edition (2020) and amending the Administrative provisions of the Building Code.

EXPLANATION: To maintain compliance with State Statutes, Wellington is required to re-adopt and resubmit local administrative amendments to Florida Building Code Chapter 1 during the current adoption cycle. The new Florida Building Code 7th Edition (2020) adopted by the State of Florida goes into effect on December 31, 2020. The proposed Ordinance amends Chapter 18 of the Wellington Code of Ordinances and amends the attached language titled "Amendments to the Florida Building Code 7th Edition (2020) Chapter 1 - Administration".
