ITEM: RESOLUTION NO. R2017-08 (REQUIREMENTS AND DUTIES OF APPOINTED CANVASSING BOARD MEMBER AND ALTERNATE)

A RESOLUTION OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL ADOPTING REQUIREMENTS AND OUTLINING DUTIES FOR AN APPOINTED CANVASSING BOARD MEMBER AND AN ALTERNATE IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE CHARTER; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

REQUEST: Approval of Resolution No. R2017-08 adopting eligibility requirements and outlining duties for an appointed canvassing board member and an alternate member in compliance with the Village Charter.

EXPLANATION: On March 15, 2016, an amendment to the Village Charter was approved by the voters requiring that, in those years in which the Canvassing Board will be comprised of an even number of members, a community member and an alternate be appointed to avoid such even number.

Resolution No. R2017-08 sets forth the eligibility requirements for and duties of the community canvassing board member and the alternate.
