ITEM: RESOLUTION NO. R2018-15 (MODIFICATION TO EXISTING SPEED HUMP POLICY)

A RESOLUTION OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. R2007-36 OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA AND ADOPTING A NEW POLICY FOR THE INSTALLATION OF SPEED HUMPS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF WELLINGTON; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

REQUEST: Council approval of Resolution No. R2018-15, as presented, repealing the speed hump policy adopted in Resolution No. R2007-36 and adopting a new policy to include language applicable to public and private roads within the Village of Wellington.

EXPLANATION: The Village of Wellington approved Resolution No. R2007-36 on March 20, 2017 adopting a policy for the installation of speed humps on certain types of streets as a traffic control measure. Since its adoption, the criteria in this policy has been utilized for the approval or denial of all speed hump requests within the Village of Wellington, whether on public or private streets.

Staff wishes to modify this policy to include language to separate the speed hump requirements for public and private streets and right-of-ways. The new language will reduce the Village's involvement in private streets and right-of-ways.
