ITEM: ORDINANCE NO. 2020-05 (AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE III, CHAPTER 58, SECTION 58-69 ENTITLED ISSUANCE OF RECEIPT)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 58, ARTICLE III, SECTION 58-69 OF WELLINGTON'S CODE OF ORDINANCES, TITLED "ISSUANCE OF RECEIPT," TO ELIMINATE THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE RECEIPT BE SIGNED BY A VILLAGE OFFICIAL; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

REQUEST: Approval of Ordinance No. 2020-05 amending Article III, Chapter 58, Section 58-69 entitled Issuance of Receipt.

EXPLANATION: Wellington's Council, pursuant to the authority granted to it in Chapters 163 and 205, *Florida Statutes*, is authorized and empowered to levy a business tax.

Wellington is required to issue a business tax receipt to the payee of the business tax, but such receipt need not be physically signed by a Village official.

Wellington is converting its internal business processes to a new Enterprise Resource Planning System ("ERP") and using its ERP system, Wellington will be able to issue business tax receipts electronically, thereby streamlining its processes and improving customer service.
